The Diuble Family Vision Foundation was formed to address those obstacles we wanted to overcome, namely fighting blindness and being able to impact people's lives for the good. The purpose of the DFV is to support research for treatment of cures, provide public awareness and to promote the well-being of persons with disabilities or the underprivileged.

We have two main projects that we are currently prioritizing funding for and the first one we have partnered with The Foundation for Fighting Blindness, a national nonprofit and the world's leading private source for retinal disease research funding. FFB is committed to driving research until the entire spectrum of retinal degenerative diseases is eradicated.

The second is our WHIP Project, that is focused on providing alarm systems (free of charge) for hearing impaired people. Our goal is to reach out to as many as possible in our surrounding communities to help instruct and provide these life-saving devices.
